

# **General Terms and Conditions of Use (GTCU) and Data Privacy Policy**

## **CROSS-BORDER CYBERSECURITY TOUR #1**

March 20, 2025 – Saarbrücken | March 21, 2025 – Metz

### **1. Event Registration**

1.1. By registering for the CROSS-BORDER CYBERSECURITY TOUR #1, participants agree to these General Terms and Conditions of Use.

1.2. Registration is required to attend the event. Participants must provide accurate and complete information during the registration process.

1.3. Registration grants participants access to the event on the specified dates: March 20, 2025, in Saarbrücken, and/or March 21, 2025, in Metz.

### **2. Personal Data Collection and Use**

2.1. **Data Controller:** World Trade Center Metz-Saarbrücken is responsible for the collection and processing of personal data.

2.2. **Data Collected:** The personal data collected during registration may include, but is not limited to:

- Full name
- Contact information (email, phone number)
- Professional details (job title, organization)
- Attendance preferences (e.g., public transport solution, diet, food allergies)

2.3. **Purpose of Data Collection:** Personal data is collected to:

- Process and confirm event registrations
- Facilitate event organization and communication
- Provide participants with event updates or relevant information

2.4. **Data Retention:** Personal data will be retained two years.

2.5. **Data Sharing:** Personal data may be shared with:

- Event partners, co-organizers or speakers for logistical purposes: Inspire Metz, East Side Fab, Stadt Saarbrücken, LORIA, CISPA, EDIH Saarland and CentraleSupélec.
- Service providers involved in the organization of the event (e.g., venue management)

### 3. Participants' Rights

3.1. In accordance with applicable data protection laws, participants have the right to:

- Access their personal data and request a copy
- Request correction of inaccurate or incomplete data
- Request deletion of their personal data, subject to legal requirements
- Object to the processing of their personal data under certain circumstances

- This authorization is granted free of charge and will not give rise to any financial consideration.
- World Trade Center Metz-Saarbrücken undertakes not to distort the image in such a way as to cause prejudice, and to refrain from using the photos in such a way as to infringe privacy or reputation.

- Each participant has the right to access, rectify and delete information concerning him or her.
